by joining the Garnett Council No 8
of The Allied Masonic Degrees ?**

**Named after its principal Founder W.Bro. Captain Charles Henry Garnett
The Council works 5 separate and distinctive ancient 'side' Degrees:**

**St. Lawrence the Martyr.
Knights of Constantinople.
Grand Tilers of Solomon.
Red Cross of Babylon.
Grand High Priest.**

Contrary to the title of the Order (Allied), there is no direct link between any of the five ancient 'side degrees'. Each has its own Officers and legend incorporated into the ritual. The Council is always be opened and closed in the Degree of St. Lawrence the Martyr and all the administrative business including the election and installation is carried out in this degree. A Lodge or Council in the other four Degrees is only opened and closed when a Candidate is admitted to that particular Degree and therefore the Officers in these Degrees are not progressive so there is ample opportunity for each member to have a 'party piece'.

The Council is small but select number and meets on the Second Monday in January, March, May and November at the Masonic Hall, Church Street, Lancaster. New members who are members of the Craft, Royal Arch and Mark who are interested in enacting different Masonic Ritual will be most welcome to join us.
